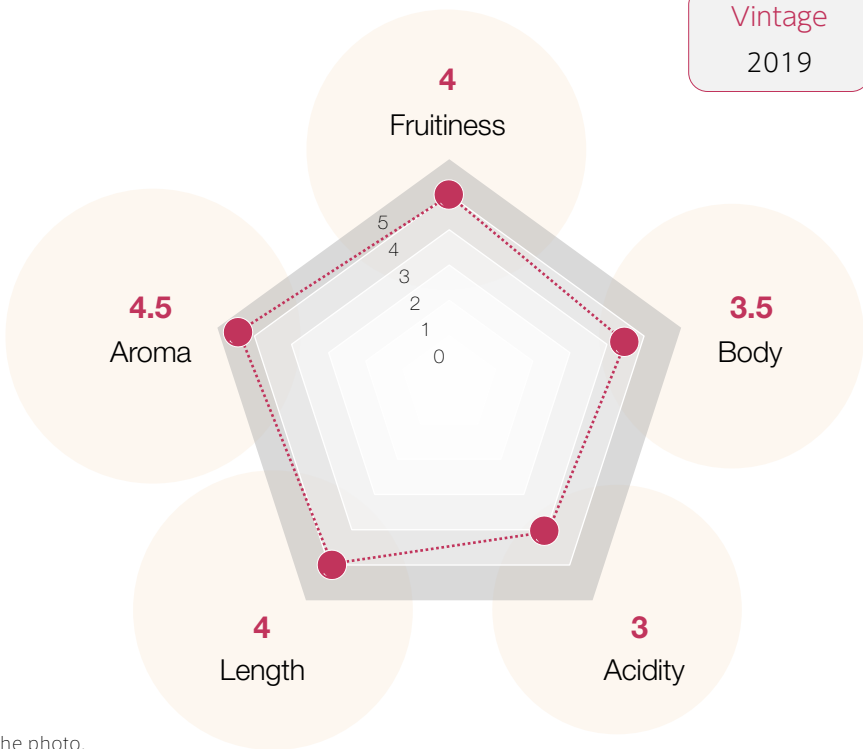

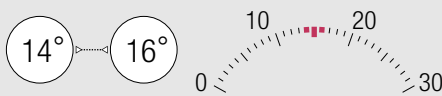

About the Vintner and Wine

- Started wine production in 1944.
- Situated in Asahimachi, Yamagata Prefecture. Seventy six percent of the town's area is covered with mountain forest, which is part of a national park, and its slogan is "a town of apples and wine."
- The grapes used by Asahimachi Wine are cultivated by 27 local farms.
- Grape varieties currently cultivated in Asahimachi include Muscat Bailey A, Black Queen, Riesling Forte, Chardonnay, and Sauvignon Blanc.
- The winery's Asahimachi Wine Castle was completed in 2000.
- Visitors can observe the grape cultivation and bottling processes and enjoy free tasting of 8 types of wine and 1 type of juice.
- There are also rare wines that can only be drunk at the Wine Castle, including the wine used at the G7 2016 Ise-Shima Summit.
