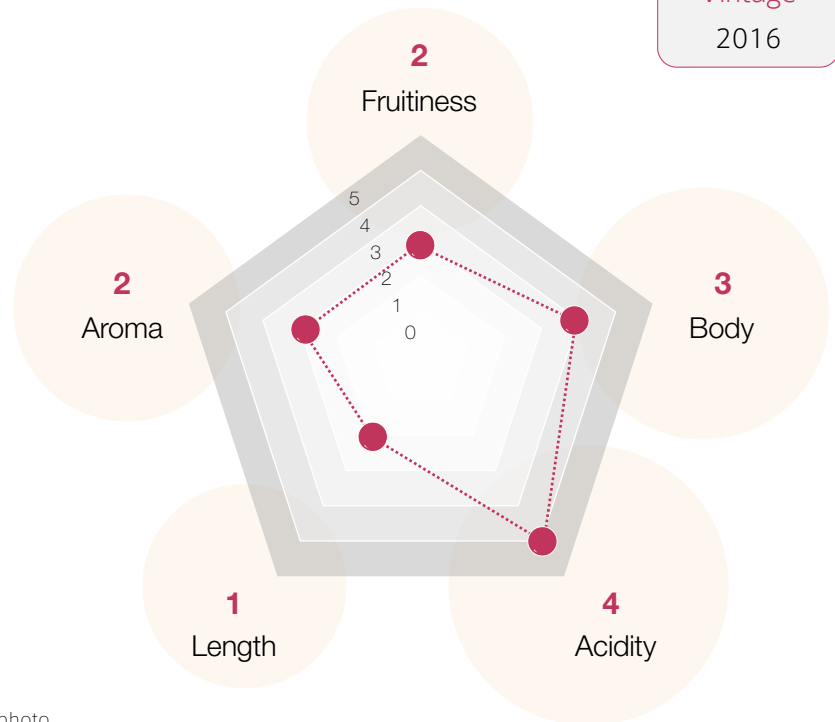

About the Vintner and Wine

- Château Mercian is one of Japan's representative wineries that is helping raise the level of Japanese wine to world class.
- It was founded in 1877 in Katsunuma, Yamanashi Prefecture.
- It comprises three wineries - Katsunuma Winery, Kikyogahara Winery, and Mariko Winery.
- At Katsunuma Winery, you can experience every aspect of Château Mercian's winemaking process, including the vineyard, and facilities such as a fermentation building, wine museum, café, tasting counter, and shop.
- Kikyogahara Winery is the birthplace of Château Mercian Shinshu Kikyogahara Merlot, the wine that won the Grand Gold Medal at the International Competition of Wine in Ljubljana in 1989, thereby putting Japanese wines on the map. It is also the original setting of the film "The Utsuke Boys".
- Mariko Winery is a new winery established in 2019 in Ueda, Nagano Prefecture, based on the concept of "a large wine resort that coexists with the community, nature, and the future". It was placed at number 30 in the World's Best Vineyards 2020 awards and selected as "Best in Asia".



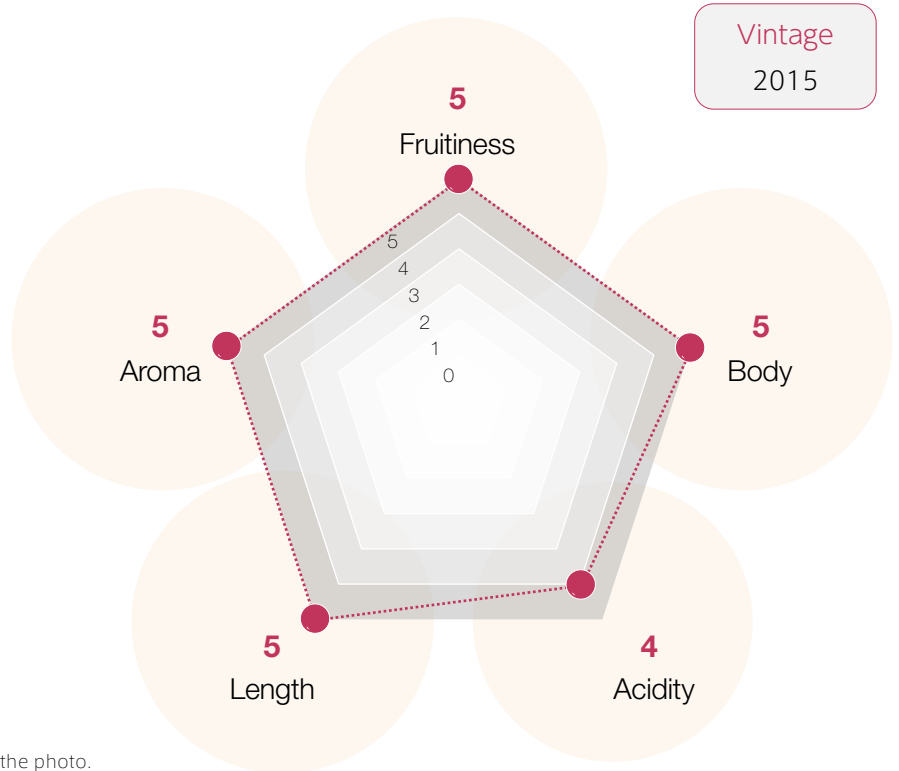
