



About the Vintner and Wine


- Tsuno Wine is a winery located in Tsuno, Miyazaki Prefecture, in the southern part of Kyushu (a small town of about 10,000 people about an hour north of Miyazaki City by car).
- \cdot It was opened in 1996 based on the idea of "small town revitalization if a winery can be built, it will transform the town."
- · After taking measures to tackle rainfall that is about five to eight times greater than most global wine producing areas and large typhoons that strike every year, it is now producing wines that are winning the admiration of journalists around the world.
- · Based on the concept that "good grapes make good wines", in addition to cultivating unique local varieties, it is also attempting to cultivate overseas varieties too. Following extensive research, it now produces a Chardonnay that has proven to be the best in Japan at Japanese wine competitions.
- · In 2007, one of its wines was selected in the "100 Most Exciting Wine Finds" by Wine Report, a report dedicated to wine that is published in the UK each year.
- · In 2019, six of Tsuno Wine's wines won awards at Hong Kong International Wine & Spirit Competition 2019, one of Asia's biggest international competitions.
- · The winery has also been selected as one of the tour destinations of the Seven Stars in Kyushu, which is a cruise-style train.
